- Continue on Rt 4 for 6.4 miles to Rt 127 in Salisbury
- At Rt 127 light and Mobil station go right for 3.2 miles, then left onto North Rd
- Continue to the end of North Rd, then turn right on Flaghole Rd.
- Go up steep hill to Humphrey Rd on the top
- At the top of the hill turn right onto Humphrey Rd
- Jack and Pam's house is the last house on the right of Humphrey Rd

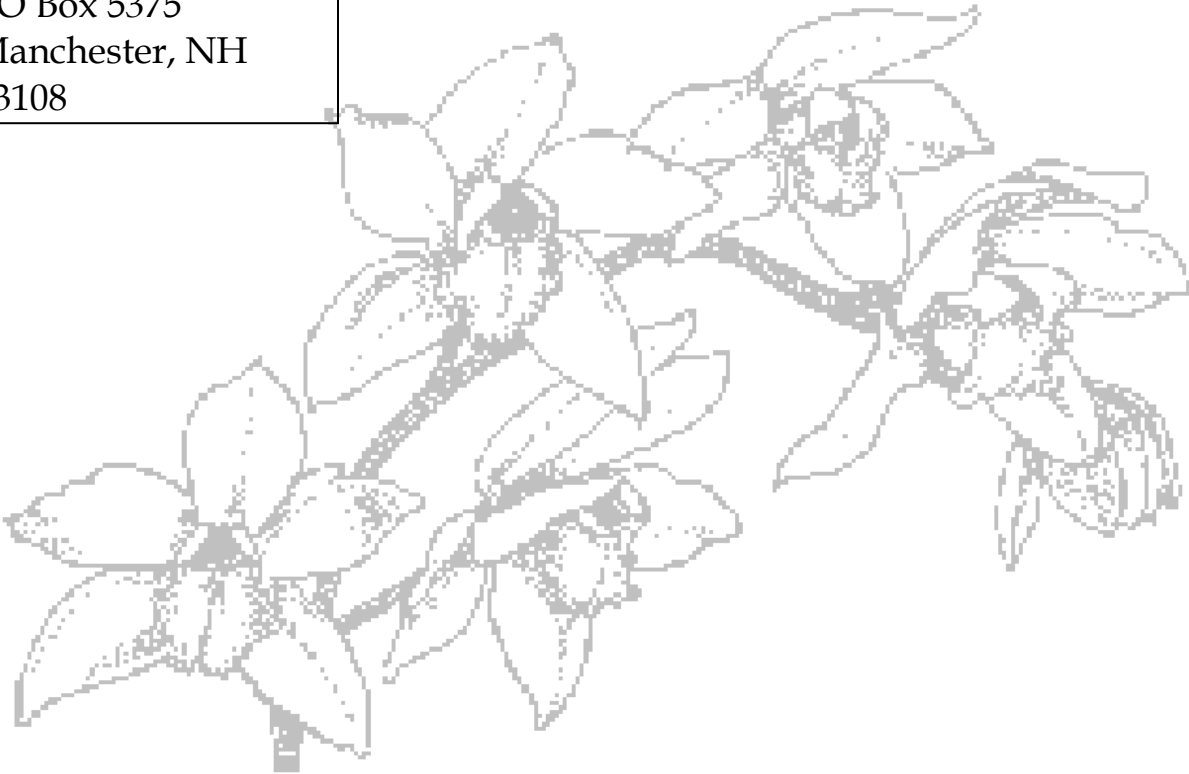
