

New Hampshire Orchid Society Business Meeting August 13, 2011

President Steve Tacopina called the meeting to order at 1:24 PM. He thanked Jack and Pam Mulder for hosting the picnic and Brenda Campbell for orchestrating the event.

Steve reminded folks that paid members get in free to the International Phalaenopsis Alliance meeting next month. However memberships must be renewed by August 31, 2011. We will need volunteers to help with set-up around 7:00 AM and with tear down once the meeting is over. The Board feels we can accommodate the meeting, vendors as well as show and food tables downstairs. There will be AOS judging at this event. Laurie will put together a menu of food items for members to bring to the meeting – it will appear in the next newsletter. We want to have an <u>outstanding</u> show table, so bring plants!

All usual September meeting events (voting for officers, approval of the budget) will take place at the October meeting. The Nominating Committee has found candidates for three of the four board positions that will be vacant in October. We are still in need of one trustee. Let Board or Nominating Committee members know if you are interested.

The Board is exploring Directors and Officers Insurance for a cost of between \$600 and \$900 per year. This would cover past, present, and future boards, officers and volunteers acting on behalf of NHOS. We will be checking for any financial advantage to obtaining our liability insurance with the same carrier.

The November meeting will be at Wentworth Gardens and will consist of a two day mini-show. On Saturday we will hold our annual fund-raising auction, so proceeds from sale of any plants members donate will go to NHOS. However the donor may be eligible for a tax deduction. Members are urged to let the Board know of any vendors/plants they would like to see in the auction.

We want a presence at the Deerfield Fair, September 28 to October 2 – Jean Stefanik will coordinate. The Massachusetts Orchid Society show will be in early November and we would like to have a display in that show.

Financially, we are in good shape with approximately \$47,000 in assets.

The theme of our 21<sup>st</sup> show in 2012 will be Parade of Orchids. There will soon be a show committee meeting at the Radisson.

David Sparks provided an update for Longwood Gardens trip 3/23-25/12. David indicated there are still openings. Daryl will put information on our FaceBook page.

Chuck Crisler said that Orchid Zone has some flasks should anyone be interested.

The meeting adjourned at 1:52 PM.

#### Myrtle Head Savanna Conservation Project

The AOS is working with The Nature Conservancy (TNC) to assist them with a management project of property TNC owns in North Carolina known as the Myrtle Head Savanna, a part of the ecologically rich Green Swamp. This is a remarkable and ecologically important area in which our collective support can help to resuscitate and sustain a critical habitat for native orchids, as well as numerous other plant and animal species. AOS has a goal to raise \$10,040.

I hope that you as individuals or your society as a group will be able to support this effort generously and be able to take pride in protecting orchids in the wild.
