- We have in immediate need for 3 or 4 people to handle the hospitality at our September/IPA meeting. We do a breakfast and a lunch. Jack Cormiea, Brenda Campbell, and Ellen Foster volunteered. Thank you! A detailed list of food donations will be published in next month's newsletter.

AOS Corner

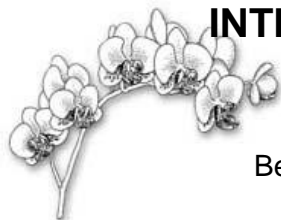

Directions to NHOS Picnic at the Crisler's

Directions

From the south on I-93, take exit 3 and turn left/west. Go about 4 miles to NH 128 and turn left/south toward Pelham. Continue below.

From the west, take Rt 111 from Nashua, through Hudson to Rt 128 in Windham. Turn right/south. Continue below.

From the northwest in Manchester, take Rt 28 south to Rt 128 south. Go through Londonderry and cross Rt. 111.

From the north east take I-93 south to exit 4/Rt 102. Go west to Rt 128. Turn left/south. Continue south and cross Rt. 111.

From Rt. 111, continue south about 1 mile to Glance Rd, which is on the left and under the BIG power lines. Go up to the top of the hill and turn left on Sunridge Rd. Mine is the fifth house on the right, the only one with a greenhouse in front!

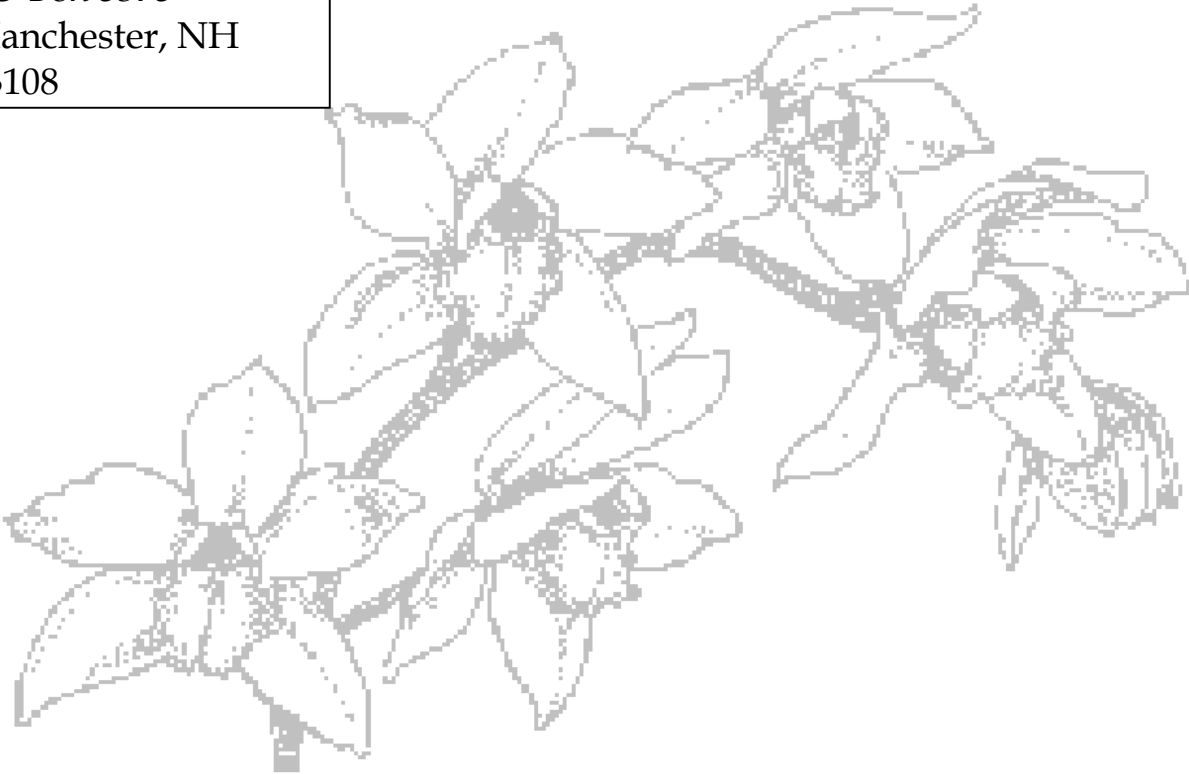
