Thursday – Feb. 7

Storage Unit 6:30 AM - 19 Kessler Farm Dr., Nashua, NH (Everett Tpk Rte.3, off exit 8)

Load rental truck with all show items from storage unit, including pipe and drape, light fixtures and bases, and storage tubs filled with show-related items. Drive truck to hotel.

Radisson Hotel 7:30 AM until Done – 11 Tara Blvd., Nashua, NH (Rte.3, off exit 1)

- 1. Unload rental truck and use glass door entrance in Ashwood Court to carry items to Ballroom.
- 2. Assemble and install pipe and drape around the perimeter of the exhibit area.
- 3. Assemble and install light fixtures in both the exhibit and vendor area.
- 4. Hang, affix and place signs in the ballroom, lobby and foyer.


