Opening

President Mattozzi called the meeting to order.


- Hospitality:
 - Thank you Ann Chepjian again for hospitality again although we haven't been getting a lot of food. Steve S. sent around a sign up for salads, sandwiches, drinks, and snacks. Sign up list will be put it in the newsletter as a reminder. We need help and donations for the IPA event in September.
- Meetings:
 - June will be our members' auction. Each member is limited to 10 plants. No presales and no reserves. Credit cards will be accepted. 80% of the auction prices goes to the member, 20% to NHOS.
 - July's speaker will be Roddy Gabel from US Fish and Wildlife Service. He will speak about CITES and how that works with orchids, the changes in the rules and the investigation and prosecution of Michael Kovach.
 - August will be our annual picnic at the Crislers
 - September will be the IPA's Third Annual Focus on Phals Day. They will have an auction (proceeds go to pay for the speakers). If you'd like a sales table, you must buy it from IPA.
 - October's speaker will be Holger Perner, expert on Paphs and other species only found in China.
- We currently have 195 memberships with a total of 275 members
- Software for membership and website management with private member section for directory, forums, photo albums
- Discussion about advancement on the show table. Every year we promote one member from Hobbyist to Advanced and one from Advanced to Expert. We'd like a better representation in the Advanced category. The board recommended the following: putting a 25 grower's commendation ribbon cumulative quota to move from Advanced to Expert. The Advanced grower with the highest number of green ribbons also receives the Sawyer Family Award. For the Hobbyist category, the grower with the highest number of points moves to Advanced and receives the Dick Valentine Trophy. Any hobbyist grower who receives 25 green ribbons will also move to Advanced. A membership vote on this was required as it is a change in the bylaws. There was a quorum of members to vote. Steve S. made a motion to vote, Lee seconded. The motion was approved.
- Marty has 3 benches and 3 HID lights for sale.

Financial Report:

• Mike reported total funds of \$46,000 with \$8000 in checking.

The meeting was adjourned and followed by the show table, lunch and the speakers' presentation.




