New Hampshire Orchid Society General Meeting April 13, 2013

Opening

President Mattozzi called the meeting to order.

Announcements:

- A trustee position has opened up as Jen Marrs has taken a new job at her company.
- NHOS has 272 paid members with 195 memberships.
- Annual show:
 - The board discussed issues we had with the Radisson for this year's annual show. The consensus is to continue with the hotel and extend our contract. Our show is branded as the Valentine's Show, the Nashua Show with a great draw from MA. We will ask the hotel if they can help us out – we lost \$7,500 and were under \$10,000 at the door.
 - \circ $\,$ We need a show chair $\,$
- Show table:
 - Majority of our members are Hobbyists with less than a handful in the Advanced category
 - Annually, the Hobbyist with the highest point total moves to the Advanced category.
 - Annually, the Advanced grower with the most grower commendation ribbons moves to the Expert category.
 - The board is thinking of setting a minimum number of grower commendation ribbons to move to the Expert category
- Local shows:
 - How do we attract more members to support our away shows? The board will review our policies for our next meeting
 - Currently, we reimburse mileage at the GSA rate of \$0.565/mile and 1 night hotel room.
 - Chuck Wingate suggested a \$250 stipend and expenses
- Auction of Marty Epstein's collection
 - We had a great time last month
 - o Sold over 350 plants in record time
 - Raised over \$10,000
 - At the members' auction, NHOS gets 20% of the proceeds; Marty donated \$7,000 to NHOS with the stipulation to use some of the money for something for the membership such as a trip to the SEPOS Show, the Philadelphia Flower Show, the Smithsonian, etc.
 - As special recognition for his donation, the board granted Marty a NHOS lifetime membership.
 - Some of the plants Tom Mirenda purchased are being donated to the Smithsonian in Marty's and NHOS' name.

• Hospitality:

We need people to bring sandwiches, drinks, snacks, and desserts. We thank Jeff and Ann for all their help.

Financial Report:

• Mike reported total funds of \$49,191.

The meeting was adjourned and followed by the show table, lunch and the speaker's presentation.

Interesting Orchid Hybrid Trivia from AOS Website

The total number of grex names in the register is currently 154,660 (as of now). This figure increases daily. Each year The International Orchid Register adds between 3000-4000 new hybrids.

The most popular genera for hybrids are:

Phalaenopsis — 31,382 Paphiopedilum — 23,871 Cymbidium — 14,688 Dendrobium — 11,910

So far there are about 2349 hybrid generic names, but not all of these are in use.

There are about 5,600 species involved in hybridization.


