- Norm will call a meeting of the show committee.

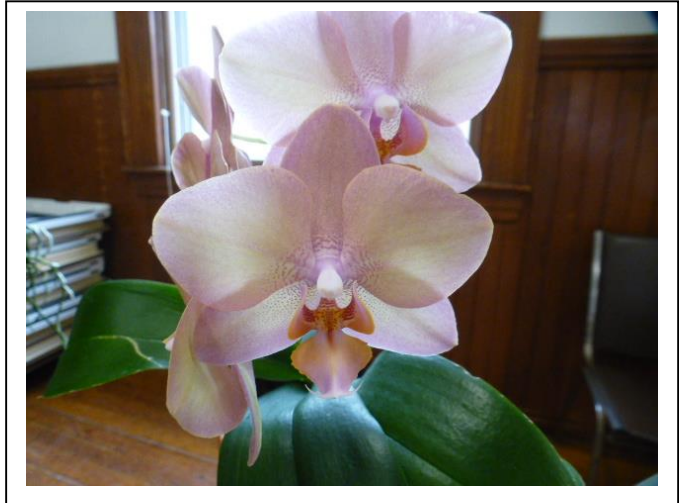
### **Program next month**

The meeting was adjourned for the show table, luncheon, and AOS judging.

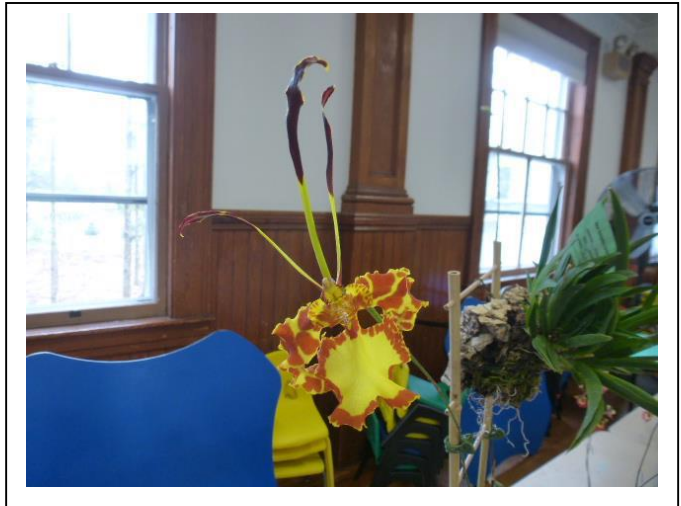
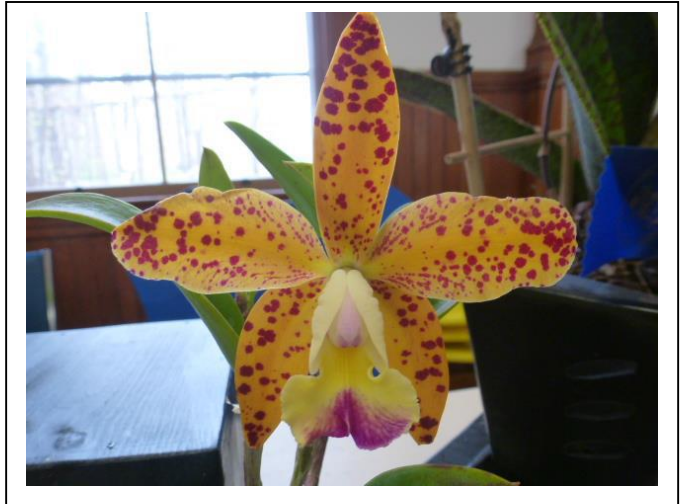
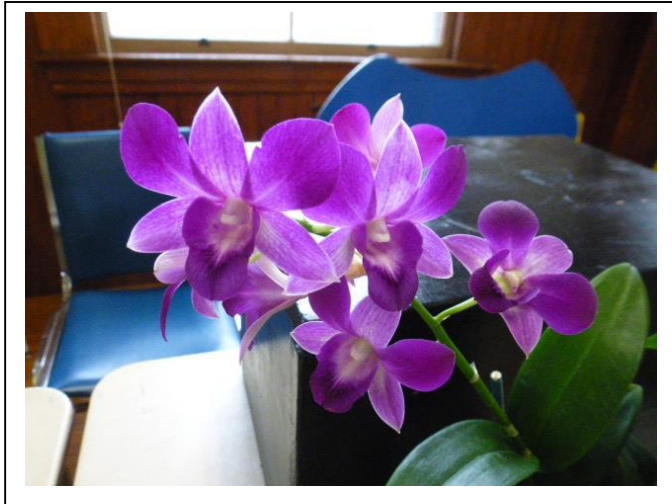
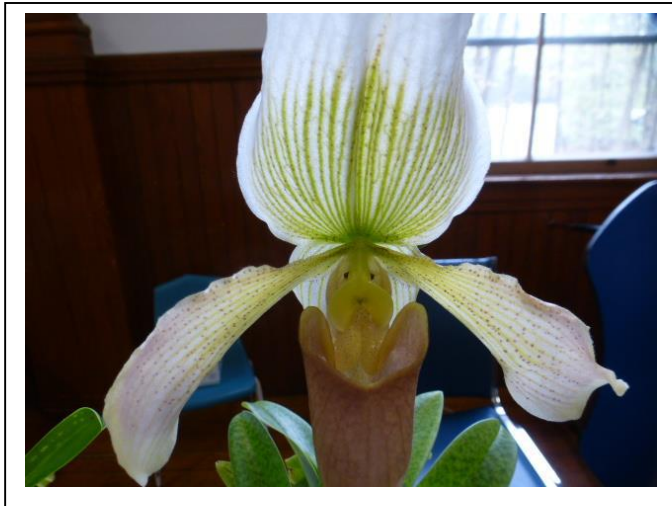
