From the east or west, take NH 111 to Windham to NH 128 (Mammoth Rd) on the west side on Windham. Turn south, toward Pelham.

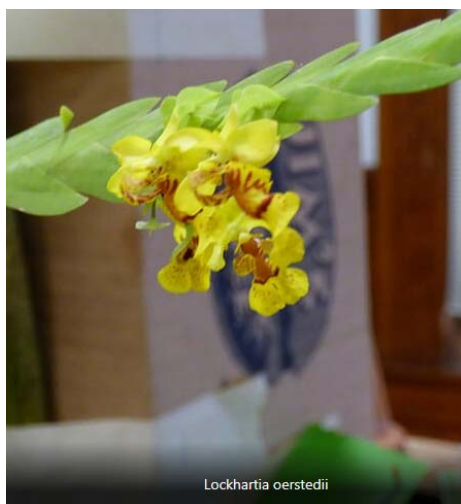
From the north on 93, take exit #4 (NH 102) west to Mammoth Rd. Turn south (toward Windham/Pelham) and cross NH 111.

After crossing NH 111, continue south about 1 mile to the **BIG** power lines crossing the road. Turn left on Glance Rd. Go up to the top of the hill and turn left on Sunridge Rd, which is the only left off of Glance. Mine is the 5<sup>th</sup> house on the right, which corresponds to the 5<sup>th</sup> driveway on the right.

Mark your calendars now for our 5<sup>th</sup> annual Fall weekend of IPA Regional Meetings in the northeast ! We explore many of the best orchid hotspots on this incredible island, along with many wildlife and cultural visits along the way.
