

- We have \$4,200 in checking and approximately \$42,000 in assets.
- December's Members Auction grossed \$1591 and netted the society \$344.03.
- We have 138 memberships.
 - o We will offer \$10 off the price of membership at our show; this is an 18 month membership
- NHOS won the AOS Show Trophy at MOS show. The certificate was presented to Sue Anderson who designed our display.



Load rental truck with all show items from storage unit, including pipe and drape, light fixtures and bases, and storage tubs filled with show-related items. Drive truck to hotel.
