
## President's Message

    - Membership revenue is slightly down

    - There was no discussion except components of the losses.
  - Our proposed 2015-2016 budget puts us a back in the black thanks to a \$20 donation from Dr. Wingate.
  - Member Andrea Deachman is in the hospital. Please sign the cards Brenda is passing around. They will brighten her day.
  - We will have an auction today with donated plants. Please sign up and take a paddle. There were pests that have been cleaned.
  - o Chuck Crisler, Chuck Anderson, and Bob Cleveland have plants for sale as well.


