Conservation News

Showy Lady Slipper Success!

Brenda Campbell shared this photo and some comments about the seedling *Cypripedium reginae* she planted. In her words, "Wanted to share this with you. It's the native lady slipper I got last year and planted at the farm. Only 2 popped up this year vs the 3 there were last but it came back! " I responded that her success was worth noting, and asked about how and where she planted them. Brenda replied, " The area I put them in is as pretty much what you see. Partial shade on the edge of an area that can be pretty wet...lots of fern and blue flag around. I don't think the area ever gets total sun but I haven't really kept track of that.

Soil is mostly decomposed materials and I planted so the top of the dirt in the pot was just a bit below the natural soil line. Covered with natural mulch about 4-6" deep. And crossed my fingers J So hope I get blooms this year but realize it may take another 1 or 2 before they feel part of the landscape."

In a recent conversation with Dr. Peter Faletra from Crossroads Academy in Lyme, NH, from where the seedlings were obtained, It seems that success is not that common. My own "experiment" did not fare well, I think perhaps not enough mulch, and possibly a hungry chipmunk might have contributed to their demise.

We'd like to hear from others who have tried planting the Cyp. reginae seedlings in the past few years... please let us know what your success has been. Note also, that Dr. Faletra is willing to provide complementary replacements (probably for fall planting) in exchange for feedback on what worked and what didn't... simply contact him at Crossroads Academy (www.crossroadsacademy.org) and explain the situation.
