## Report from the World Orchid Conference in Guayaquil, Ecuador By Jean Stefanik

#### WOC 22 = WOW!!

Here's a few photos from the World Orchid Congress which was held in early November in Guayaquil, Ecuador. Ann Chipjian and her husband, Norm Selander-Carrier and I attended, each crossing paths now and then in the huge venue. We were blown away by the displays, the diversity of orchids, especially South American species, which accounted for at least 75% of the show. After an exhausting day of incredible judging (I was assigned to the "Pleurothallids, including ALL except Masdevallias" team), I left with a sense of awe at the many species represented. I could see Ann had fun shopping for orchids too! There was great variety and quality in the four days of lectures by both well-known and respected researchers, and young orchid scientists as well. Networking with orchid enthusiasts and friends from around the world was one of the highlights of the experience for me.

Equaflor-A created a floor display complete with a volcano covered with orchids on its sides. Ecuagenera was awarded the "Best Exhibit" which was immense and multi-dimensional, with large terrariums, walls of orchids, a display showing propagation and flasking; all with flowering orchids from Ecuador and around the world.

In three years the WOC gathering will meet in Taiwan, which produced a dazzling display with primarily Phalaenopsis. It was announced that Perth, Australia won the bid for the WOC in 6 years. They celebrated, handed out little Koala bears, and even had a T-shirt printed in limited quantities! Start planning now!!!
