DIRECTIONS TO 87 Babb Meadow Lane, Mason, NH

From the blinking yellow light on NH Rt. 13. in Brookline, NH, turn west onto Mason Road.

Continue on Mason Road, bearing left at any forks.

After about two miles from the blinking light you will see the runway of Brookline Airport on your right.

Babb Meadow Lane is the first paved Road on your right after the Airport. There will be a sign at the intersection that says NHOS.

Go right on Babb Meadow Lane. # 87 is the second driveway on the right. The house has a red roof with solar collectors on top. You can park in the driveway, along both sides of the road and in the hammerhead at the end of the road. Please do not block any driveways.

If you pass Parker's Maple Barn Restaurant on your left you have gone too far. Turn around and go back. Babb Meadow Lane will be the first paved road on your left.
