

New Hampshire Orchid Society General Meeting Minutes February 12, 2022

The President called the meeting to order and welcomed members and guests.

- Financials We have \$9,718.03 in the checking account, \$27,391.72 in the fund accounts.
- Chuck Wingate met with the Board to discuss the points needed for Hobbyist to proceed into the Advanced Category. It was determined that 50 points would be needed to advance. Points received from Cultural awards would carry over from year to year but points received from placing 1-3 would revert back to zero at the beginning of the year if the pre-requisite 50-point total had not been reached. If a person in Hobbyist received the pre-requisite 50 points and accumulated 20 Cultural awards, they must remain in Advanced Category for 1 year before moving into Expert (20 cultural awards are needed to advance to Expert).

 - March 2022– Show preparation Meeting and Annual Show and Sale 2022.
 - April Welcome Meeting for new members and Francisco Miranda of Miranda Orchids will be the speaker (program information not available).

 - June 2022 Tim Culbertson (program information not available).
 - July 2022 Kristen Uthus (program information not available).
 - August 2022 Annual Meeting and Picnic (location to be announced).
 - September 2022 Nothing scheduled.
 - October 2022 Annual Member's and Vendor's Auction 2022.
 - November 2022 Kelly McCracken from High Desert Orchids will speak on Artificial Lighting.
 - December 2022 Nothing scheduled.
- CAIOS, Amherst and Deep Cut have been cancelled due to Covid-19 Omicron variant.
- Membership reported that we currently have 83 memberships and 133 members.
- Annual Show and Sale Brenda and Andrea went over our upcoming Show and Sale and urged members to volunteer for assignments: set-up/tear-down, Admissions, Member Co-Op, Tours, Clerking, Trophy Donations to name a few.

Feb. Meeting Minutes Continued

- We currently have 8 vendors who will be participating. A questionnaire will be distributed to the Membership asking for help. We will be reaching out to other Societies asking for their participation with displays and to fill some of the vacant positions. It was stated that as of now thru the end of February, Nashua has a masking requirement and it is unknown if it will be lifted after that date. It was stressed that if people who have volunteered are unsure to please mask-up. An update on information gathered as to future dates for NHOS' Show and Sale was discussed. It was discovered that the Hotels have a busy season which starts in March and ends in October. The Hotels will book venues that draw large amounts of revenue. Resulting from this discovery it was determined that March would not be a viable date for our next Show and Sale and that we would be required to return to February as we have done in the past. Therefore, next year's Show and Sale will be held in February.
- Meeting was adjourned for the Show Table and monthly program.



NHOS Member's Co-op Table

REQUIREMENTS FOR SELLING PLANTS AT THE Co-op TABLE

There isn't any limit on the number of plants each member can sell but plants will be placed onto the Co-op table proportional to the number of members selling plants. Plants being used to refresh stock will be placed under the table. Please provide a typed listing (your name, plant name and price) with a line item for each plant. Double tag your plants with name of plant, your name/initials and price on each tag. It is important to note that accounting is very important and members that do not provide a typed listing of plants/items and without the double tag will need to do so before plants can be placed on the table for sale.

PREPARING PLANTS FOR SALE

Inspect your plants for insects and signs of disease; infected/diseased plants will be removed from the table. Groom your plants to look sellable. It is understood that some plants may be recent divisions needing to be secured with rhizome clips or stakes. Keep in mind that many people may handle them during the day.

NON-PLANT ITEMS SHIRTS/PRINTS ETC.

Requirements for selling non-plant items remains the same as for the selling of plants. In addition to the typed listing and double tag the total number of each item (i.e., 20 5x7, 30 4x6 or 2-short sleeve, $15 \log$ sleeves, etc.) is also required.

PARTICIPATION AT THE Co-Op TABLE

Members planning to sell plants/items are expected to volunteer some of their time helping out at the Co-op table. Please let us know what your availability is (days, time and duration and any other considerations).


