






New Hampshire Orchid Society General Meeting Minutes Sept. 9, 2023

The President called the meeting to order and welcomed members and guests.


- We need help setting up before and cleaning up after the meeting. Please don't leave the responsibility to only a few. All help is appreciated.





A message from the desk of Susan Usseglio - NHOS Secretary

With the notification from our Membership of inadequate Handicapped Parking availability, I did some checking to see if there were options that could be explored to rectify this situation and would not land me in jail. I am here to report that in fact there are.

In speaking with the Bedford Police Department, it was suggested that I contact the Town Clerk since this is their domain. In speaking with Jane O'Brien, she understood completely our request and in turn contacted the Bedford Police Department (making sure that I would not land in jail) and was told we would be all set. We will be designating three (3) additional spaces as "Handicapped Only Parking". Jane also informed me that we currently have 4 spaces available to us now; there are two spaces in the upper parking lot next to the Town Hall, two more spaces directly behind in front of the building and are marked. With the addition of these three we will have 7 spaces available for our members.

These additional three spaces will be marked with signs (approval was received from the Treasurer for this minor purchase) and will be the first three spaces in the upper parking lot on the street side. The signs will be posted on Meeting days, they will be removed at the end of the meeting. These signs will remain in the Town Hall beside our cabinet in the main room.

Member's Choice for September Aerangis mystacidii 'Cleveland's'

Grown by Bob Cleveland



According to IOSPE: fragrant, 80% shade, hot to cool grower, blooms summmer to fall.

Common Name or Meaning The Mystacidium-like Aerangis

Flower Size 1 1/4" [2.3cm]

This minature, epiphytic species is found in South Africa, Zimbabwe, Mozambique, Malawi and Zambia in riverine forests, in gorges and along streams on small twigs overhanging water as well as evergreen or woodland forests away from water with high rainfall at elevations of 60 to 1800 meters with short to 4" [10 cm] long carrying 2 to 8 oblanceolate to obovate, leathery to slightly fleshy, unequally bilobed apically leaves that blooms with a arching to pendant, 12" [30cm] long, inflorescence that carries from 3 to 25, nocturnally fragrant [lily of the valley] flowers occuring in the summer and fall and is best cork mounted with cool to hot temperatures, moderate shade, high humidity in the growing season and a cooler drier rest.

Synonyms Aerangis mystacidioides Schltr. 1915; Aerangis pachyura Schlechter 1918; *Angraecum mystacidii Rchb. f. 1847; Angraecum pachyurum Rolfe 1813; Angraecum saundersiae Bolus 1888

Fairly easy to grow if you can provide high humidity. Can be grown in a pot with very loose media but probably grows and displays best mounted with multiple waterings per week.
